O'Bannon Woods State Park; **Located at Harrison-Crawford State Forest**

The forest has 25,000 acres with some of the most beautiful horse trails in Indiana. There are two major rivers, the Ohio & Blue Rivers.

Youcan ride on the horse trails and enjoy tubing on the Blue river. Indian Creek is also a great place to water your horse. The trails are very scenic, rating from moderate to rugged terrain. The campground has wooded, shaded & sunny campsites with water nearby, horse wash stations, and horse tie racks. There is primitive camping (generators allowed) with showers, and full electric camping sites for horse campers. The park also offers a pool with water slides.

Note: The current "100 Mile Ride" does not cover a full 100 miles as it did in the "Good Old Days."


