OLD CAPITOL SADDLE CLUB QUEEN

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Contestant must never have been married or have had any children.
- 2. Contestant must be at least 15 years old and no more than 20 years old on January 1st, on the year of her rein.
- 3. No-one may be queen for 2 consecutive years.
- 4. Must be a registered member of Old Capitol Saddle Club.
- 5. Contestant must provide club with an application, signed by parents or guardians, by the November meeting.
- 6. Contestants must give a short talk about themselves (approximately 5 minutes) at the November meeting.
- 7. Voting for the queen will be at the November meeting by secret ballot, and officially crowned at the Christmas party.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. The queen is to represent the club by demonstrating a positive attitude and good sportsmanship. She must demonstrate honorable behavior and appearance, both in and out of the arena.
- 2. While representing the club in official appearances, she will wear the crown and sash, except while competing.
- 3. Appearances that are required
 - a. Bean and soup supper
 - b. Christmas Party
 - c. Participate in 3 events at the 100 mile ride, one of which will be handing out the trophies on the awards presentation evening.
 - d. Other duties as requested by club

The club will reimburse the elected queen for up to \$150 toward the purchase of a western hat and appropriate outfit. The outfit must be approved arena attire with the exception that the shirt may be short sleeved.

The club will furnish a tiara and a sash. The sash will have the following wording: "OLD CAPITOL SADDLE CLUB QUEEN".

The queen will be given a free ride on the 100 mile trail ride the year of her rein. There will be picture taken of the queen and the club will cover the cost of the setting fee (as long as the queen uses the photographer the committee has arranged). An 8 X 10 will be given to the queen.

Only the present year OCSC queen can be sponsored for the Harrison County Fair Queen Contest

No member of the contestant's immediate family will count the votes.

Application

Any contestant accepting the queen position must be willing to assume the following duties/responsibilities:

Represent the club by demonstrating a positive attitude, good sportsmanship, and honorable behavior, both in and out of the arena.

The Queen will wear the tiara and sash while representing the club (except when competing). Present awards at the 100 Mile Trail Ride and any Horse Shows sponsored by the club, (except when competing).

Helping at the Ham & Bean Supper, Christmas Party and other club functions.

Contestant must never have been married nor have children.

Contestant must be at least 15 years old and no more than 20 years old on January 1 of the year of her reign.

No one may be queen for 2 consecutive years.

Contestant must be a member of the club.

Contestant must provide club with an application, signed by contestant and parent or guardian by the November meeting.

Each Contestant must give a short presentation (5 minutes) about them self at the November meeting.

The Queen will reign for one calendar year (Jan-Dec).

The club will reimburse the elected queen for up to \$150 toward the purchase of a western hat and outfit. The outfit must be approved arena attire with the exception that short sleeves are acceptable.

The club will furnish the tiara and sash.

The Queen's 100 Mile Trail Ride fee will be waived.

The Queen will be voted on at the November meeting by secret ballot.
